SUPPLY LIST

TAKING YOUR WORK TO THE NEXT LEVEL On Track Studios, Aug. 12 -14, 2021, 9am-4pm

2 - 3 MEDIUM SIZE CANVAS OR CANVAS BOARDS

Suggested sizes can be from 16 x 20 to 20 x24. You can use whatever size and surface you like. You can work on either a stained or white canvas, your preference. One or two canvases will be used for exercises and the other one will be used to begin a studio painting.

PAINT / BRUSHES

Bring the selection of colors and brushes that you normally use.

PAINTING MEDIUM

Bring the medium of your choice if you normally use one.

ODORLESS SOLVENT IN AN UNBREAKABLE CONTAINER

Gamsol is preferred. This is to clean your brushes at the end of the day.

PAPER TOWELS AND TRASH BAGS

Moist hand wipes are helpful in cleaning up.

PALETTE KNIFE FOR MIXING

A MIDDLE VALUE PALETTE

This type palette will be useful in seeing the value of both light and dark mixtures.

PHOTO REFERENCE OR SKETCHES FOR A STUDIO PAINTING

Subject matter can be people, landscape, interiors etc. You can work from digital images on a iPad or laptop, or you can work from prints.

GROCERY BAG SKETCH SUPPLIES

Paper will be furnished. The palette of oil paint is the same as used for your other paintings. You will need a pencil and eraser plus a few small synthetic brushes. I am using small synthetic brushes listed here, but you can just bring any small synthetic brushes you have. Small flats from 1/8"wide to 1/4" wide. A rigger or other round brush for any lines you want to include in your sketch.
